In Maths this week we will be deepening our understanding of numbers 4 and 5 by exploring and remembering all the different ways we can make (compose) these numbers.

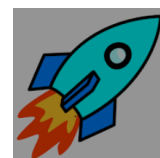


Topic

(Expressive Arts and Design and Understanding the World)
