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Teaching Points: *Encourage your child to point to each sound and blend the sounds together to read the words. They should practice writing the words out themselves and then draw the sound buttons on to help them identify where they need to blend the sounds.*

Your child can practice reading and writing sentences with the tricky words. They could practice forming the words with different objects and media such as playdough, sand, paint, marbles, toy cars etc.
