Information about some of the things we will be learning in the week beginning 13th December 2021




English This wek we will be writing a diary entry for the Great Fire of London inspired by all the learning we have done about Samuel Pepys.

We will be looking to add in details about what we saw, what we heard and how we were feeling. We will be focusing on saying our sentences out loud before we write them down. We will check each sentence has a capital letter and full stop. We will then read our diary out loud to check it makes sense.

Maths:

This week in maths we will be looking at some Christmas puzzles and problems. The children will be using their arithmetic learning from this term including adding tens and ones and taking away 2 digit numbers.
