Sun Safety Reminders

Thank you for keeping absence to a minimum. This really helps your child get the best from their educational opportunities.

Our target is 95% attendance - for us, it is not about whether a child is statutory school age or not – it's about every child accessing their entitlement to a really good education, and building their learning year on year.

Reporting Absence - Please notify the school at the start of the day on the first day should your child be unable to attend due to reasons such as illness or for a medical appointment, and then continue to keep in regular contact if the absence continues.

Please use the Absence tab on your ParentMail account to send the office a message.

Alternatively the school office 24 hour answerphone service is also available for reporting your child's absence.
