St Peter & St Paul Feast Day 29th June

On this day, Catholics celebrate the life of two special saints. Mass is celebrated in the parishes and in school we will hold special prayer sessions in the classes with the children and teach them about St Peter and St Paul. Class 1S will lead an assembly to celebrate these special saints on Wednesday 26th June at 9.00 am.

Did you know...

- St. Peter and St. Paul are both patron saints of Rome and considered cornerstones of the Church.
- St. Paul became a good man when he heard the voice of God and spent the rest of his life preaching the Gospel. His letters are included in the writings of the New Testament, and through them, we learn much about his life and the faith of the early Church. He is acclaimed as one of the most important apostles who spread the word of Jesus.
- St. Peter was once named Simon and he was a fisherman of Galilee. Jesus gave him the name Cephas (Petrus in Latin), which means 'Rock,' because he was to become the rock upon which Christ would build his Church. St. Peter was one of the 12 apostles, as well as the first Pope and founder of the Roman Church.

We have organised some special events for children in Year 2 as they come to the end of their time at St Joseph's:



Pupil Safety

May we remind parents to keep children with them at all times. We expect children to be delivered to the classroom door by an adult for the safety of the child. Please do not drop children off in the playground unaccompanied.

Named Property

Please ensure that all children's belongings are 'named'. This helps us to return items promptly should they become lost.

Important Reminders

Care Club Places - September 2024

An important reminder to parents currently using the Breakfast and After School Clubs – you must confirm the sessions required for your child for the new school year from September 2024 as soon as possible. Please email the school office to confirm your sessions. This is important as it helps us to plan for staffing and to know the number of places left to allocate.

Site Access

Parking in the school grounds is limited and is therefore only available to staff and other authorised users. Blue badges spaces are available on site if your child or the person dropping off or collecting your child has a Blue Badge. Please contact the school office if you need to register a Blue Badge to access the school site.

School Milk

Our school provides a milk scheme which is available to all pupils via our milk supplier Cool Milk. Free milk is available to order for all children under five. When a child turns five, parents have the opportunity to pay a subsidised rate for their child to continue to receive milk in school.

Pupils entitled to Pupil Premium funding are entitled to free school milk.
